

Public Notice

Pursuant to the Arkansas Operating Air Permit Program, 8 CAR § 42-502, the Arkansas Department of Energy and Environment (E&E), Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Office of Air Quality gives the following notice:

Associated Electric Cooperative, Inc. - Dell Power Plant (47-00448) operates a facility located at 301 East State Highway 18, Dell, AR 72426. This facility has submitted an application to remove the restriction of using only No. 2 fuel oil (SC#6) for the turbines (SN-01 and SN-02) and remove the PM, PM₁₀, and VOC five year testing requirements for the turbines when running on fuel oil (SC#11 and #13). There are no changes to the facility's operation or permitted annual emission limits.

The application has been reviewed by DEQ staff and has received DEQ's tentative approval subject to the terms of this notice.

Comments will be accepted in accordance with 8 CAR § 11-208. During the public comment period, any person may submit written comments to DEQ at the above address Attention: DEQ Air Permits Branch or to ee.airpermits@arkansas.gov by email. Any interested person may request a public hearing on the draft permitting decision during the public comment period. The public comment period shall begin on the day this notice is published and shall expire at 4:30 p.m. Central Time on the thirtieth (30th) calendar day after publication of this notice.

The Director shall make a final decision to issue or deny this application or to impose special conditions in accordance with 8 CAR § 11-211 of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission's Administrative Procedures (8 CAR pt. 11) and 8 CAR pt. 42.
